

RARITAN VALLEY ROAD RUNNERS EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING: JUNE 10, 2004

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Executive Board Meeting of the Raritan Valley Road Runners was called to order at 7:11 pm by President Bob Townley at Allen Pauls' Carpet Store.

II. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING:

III. PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Bob asked how new running program is going? To attract new runners it was suggested that we should make the website more appealing to non-runners. One suggestion was to emphasize social activities and de-emphasize racing results.

Ken will spend approximately \$10 per week on post Wednesday night refreshments.

Bob will inquiry as to if the cafeteria will be available for the general membership meeting.

Jonathan submitted an article for 5/22 newsletter and Ray and Erica will do the same for 6/22.

Bob mentioned that Kathy Rocker wanted to hold time trails. He will ask her to lead those efforts.
